Tests and Screenings Available

Lipid Panel -- \$12.00 (Do not eat for 12 hours prior to test. Results include Cholesterol, Triglycerides, HDL, LDL, VLDL, & C/H Ratio)

Comprehensive Metabolic Profile (CMP) -- \$15.00 (Do not eat for 12 hours prior to test. Results include BUN, Calcium, CO₂, Chloride, Creatinine, Glucose, Potassium, & Sodium)

Complete Blood Count (CBC) -- \$15.00 (White Blood Cell Count, Red Blood Cell Count, Hemoglobin, Hematocrit, Platelet Count, & Auto Differential Count)

Prostate (PSA) MEN ONLY -- \$25.00 (Levels for detecting prostate problems)

Thyroid (TSH) -- \$20.00 (High values may be related to hormone therapy, birth control pills, or medications)

Hemoglobin A1C (HbA1C) -- \$25.00 (Provides information about a person's average levels of blood glucose, also called blood sugar, over the past 3 months)
