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POLICY B-20.1
USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS AND NICOTINE DELIVERY DEVICES

The use of tobacco products and/or nicotine delivery devices is prohibited in any school building owned or operated by the district and in school vehicles. Staff members may choose to smoke in their vehicles or use nicotine delivery devices, but under no circumstance is a tobacco product or nicotine delivery devices to be used when supervising students as part of the work schedule or during school activities where students are present. The “Designated Smoking Area” for employees and for visitors (adults) is the parking lot.

Enrolled students, including eligible students who have reached the age of majority, are not permitted to use tobacco products or nicotine delivery devices at school, on school grounds, in personal vehicles while on school property, or during school activities. Students that violate this policy will be subject to disciplinary action.

For the purposes of this policy, “nicotine delivery devices” means any device that can be used to deliver nicotine or nicotine salts to the person inhaling from the device. Such definition shall include, but not be limited to, any electronic cigarette, cigar, cigarillo, pipe, or personal vaporizer.
